Order of Service

It is preferable that there are no paraments, banners, flowers, or decorations on Good Friday. The Lord's table, pulpit, and other furnishings should be bare of cloth, candles, or anything else not actually used in the service. The cross remains visible, but it and any permanently fixed images may be veiled. A large wooden cross stands in the center of the chancel. Choir enters in silence.
