- Main soccer coach (teach and play with a small group of 6-12 year olds)***
- Helper soccer coach (support the main coach)***
- Sideline coach support for all the campers, with snacks, bathroom breaks, sun breaks***
- Devotion leader (support the coaching staff with a morning devotion)
- Deliver lunches for the coaches
- Welcome the campers and sign them in
- Sign out campers each day
- Set up (tents, tables, water jugs)***
- Take down (tents, tables, etc.)
- Certified First Aid attendant
- Greet families as they arrive, answer questions
- On-call Runner (available to pick up and drop off items)
