#### When We Do Not Want To Accept Responsibility, We Do Two Things:

1. We want to \_\_\_\_\_ other people.
2. We want to \_\_\_\_\_ ourselves.

#### Another Way to Look At Individualism, Secularism, and Relativism Today

1. Individualism can be called the “\_\_\_\_\_” mentality.
2. Secularism can be called the “\_\_\_\_\_” mentality.

  - † *Ephesians 5:15*, "Live life with a sense of responsibility, not as those who don't know the meaning of life, but as those who do" (PHL).
  - The key to living a more responsible life is to figure out: What did God put me on this earth \_\_\_\_\_?

#### Why Should I Live A Responsible Life?

1. Because \_\_\_\_\_ my life.
  - † *Hebrews 4:13*, "Nothing in all the world can be hidden from God. Everything is clear and lies open before Him, and to Him we must explain the way we have lived" (NCV).

#### God Put You On This Earth For 3 Primary Reasons

    - † *Hebrews 4:13b*, "... and to Him we must explain the way we have lived" (NCV).
    - † *Hebrews 4:13a*, "God knows everything, nothing is hidden" (PAR).
2. Because \_\_\_\_\_ by my life.
    - † *1 Corinthians 10:24*, "People should be concerned about others and not just about themselves" (GWT).
    - † *1 Corinthians 10:24*, "Don't think only of yourself. Try to think of the other fellow, too, and what is best for him."
  3. Because \_\_\_\_\_ it.
    - † *Deuteronomy 28:2*, "You will experience all of God's blessings if you obey the Lord" (NLT).

+ Luke 16:10, "Whoever is faithfully responsible in little things, will be given greater responsibilities" (PAR)."

### **How Can I Be More Responsible?**

#### **1. Save \_\_\_\_\_.**

+ Proverbs 21:20, "The wise man saves for the future, but the foolish man spends whatever he gets" (TLB).

+ Ecclesiastes 7:4b, "The fool thinks only about having a good time now" (NLT).

+ Luke 12:48, "Much is required from those to whom much is given, for their responsibility is greater" (TLB)."

+ Proverbs 29:11, "A fool expresses all his emotions, but a wise person controls them" (GWT).

+ Matthew 12:36, "People will be responsible for every careless word they've said" (NCV).

+ Ecclesiastes 7:20, "There's never been a person who lived on this earth who always did what was good and never did what was wrong" (PAR).

+ Romans 3:23-24, "Yes, all have sinned; all fall short of God's glorious ideal; <sup>24</sup>yet now God declares us "not guilty" of offending him if we trust in Jesus Christ, who in his kindness freely takes away our sins" (TLB).
