This last year has been a roller coaster ride of in-person and Zoom events. We are excited to be meeting in person and thank God for the interpersonal interaction that we can again enjoy. No matter the restrictions or freedoms, opportunities to share in amazing conversations abound. A Ph.D student was able to see Jesus work in his difficult circumstances and continues to ask for prayer that "Jesus would reveal Himself to me."
