

## CCG Council Meeting Summary for March 17, 2022

The council meeting focused on a number of key issues, the foremost being the re-opening of the church building. The plan that council believes most suits our needs have determined that:

- The protocols including mask wearing, sanitization, necessity of vaccine passports passed at the February 17, 2022 council meeting will still stand.
- Hybrid worship will take place on Palm Sunday April 10 and Easter Sunday April 17. Communion will be offered at the Easter Sunday service and there will be an in-person Easter sunrise service outside.
- Good Friday April 15, 2022 will be an in-person only service in the church.
- The Worship committee wants the congregation to know that we are in a period of transition and are experimenting with new approaches, some of which may or may not work.
- All meetings need to be booked through Brian Field who will post events on the Event Schedule on the website. John Peirce needs to know in advance (preferably well in advance) when meetings are booked so the heat can be turned on. Committee meetings must do their own sanitizations.

Plans were made for the AGM on March 27. These include:

- A motion to allow Betty and Owen to remain an extra year in their Council positions
- An urgent call for people to volunteer and to be “lay leaders” made by Betty and Mona.
- George will provide a final call for people to commit to a financial increase in their giving.
- A slate of candidates for the election
- A 2022 budget which council recommends to the congregation.
- The need for someone to take Jean Rhode’s position in looking after our Foster children.

Karen went through the Strategic Plan in detail and it was supported by council with the suggestion that an ad hoc committee be formed to deal with the implementation. The council thanked Karen and her committee for an excellent job in formulating the plan.

Other items of business discussed:

- Sue Lissack has agreed to continue as our Safe Church coordinator.
- A Council “social gathering” has been planned to thank Angela Nutter for her many years of service.
