Introduction:

1. What role does the Old Testament play in helping us to understand the person and work of Jesus? What do the following passages teach about Jesus and his relationship to the O.T? (See Jn.1:43-49; 5:46; Lk. 24:45-47).
2. Why should we turn to the O.T to understand what it means for Jesus to be the 'Son of God'?
3. Take some time to read through 2 Samuel 7:1-17 where God makes a covenant with David and his descendants. What are the particulars of this covenant according to vv.12-17?
4. What do the following passages have in common? (See 2 Samuel 7:12-17; Psalm 89:1-4, 24-29; Is. 9:6-7).
5. What does Luke 1:26-35 have in common with the passages listed above?
6. How do the following passages help us to understand the title 'the Son of God' as it pertains to Jesus? (See 2 Sam. 7:14; Ps. 89:26; Is. 9:6; Ps. 2:7; Lk. 1:32, 35).
7. In the O.T texts cited above the Davidic throne was located on earth. Where according to Acts 2:29-35 is the Davidic throne? Who sits on the Davidic throne now?
8. What difference does it make if Jesus is seated on the Davidic throne right now? What difference does it make if he is the 'ruler of the kings of the earth (Rev.1:5)? How should this influence your everyday thinking and living?
- 9 What is Jesus doing in heaven right now as he sits on David's throne? (See 1 Cor. 15:20-28).
