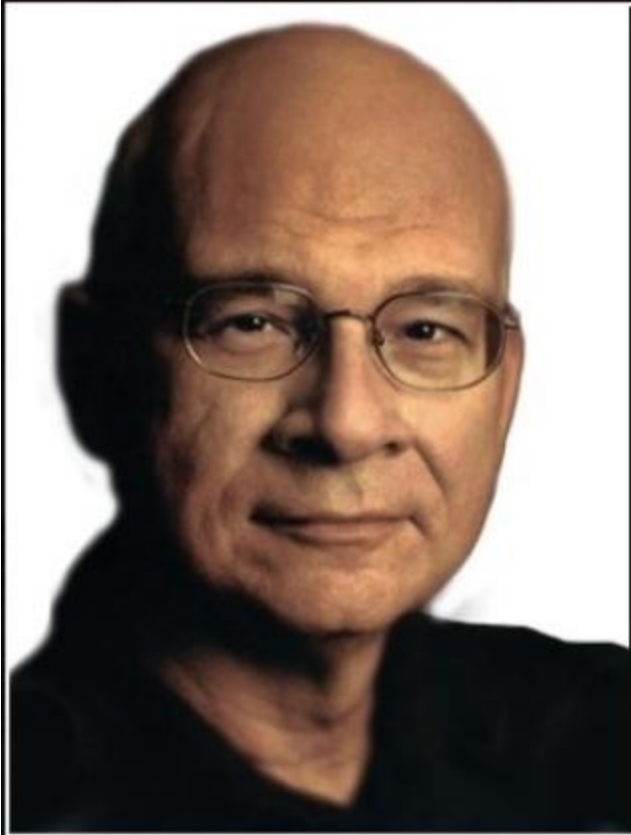

Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus, who,


**though he was in the form of God,
