Read Hebrews 6:13-15. God promised Abraham and Sarah that they would have a son in their old age. Abraham and Sarah waited 25 years before Isaac was born. During those 25 years, Abraham made a mistake, what was it?

In your own words, why did Abraham have a child with Hagar?

In the moments of waiting, what are we tempted to do?

What is the difference between waiting on God and doing nothing?

Read Acts 1:8. And Acts 2:32. After the disciples waited on God and the Holy Spirit came to them, Jesus instructed the disciples to be witnesses. A witness is one who testifies of what they have seen and heard. How do these verses apply to us today as modern day Christians?

If you've had an opportunity to be a witness to someone recently, how did that interaction or conversation take place?

What are some challenges or apprehensions you've experienced with being a witness?

What has helped you overcome those challenges or apprehensions?

Have you had the opportunity to witness to someone who made a decision, in the moment or later, to trust Christ? Please explain.
