#### deacon recommendations

The deacons have 3 recommendations to present to the congregation. If you have any questions, please contact one of the church deacons or pastors. A members' meeting will be held after the morning worship service next Sunday, May 15 to vote on the following recommendations:

- 1) Replacing the cabinets and countertops in the church kitchen (and the cheering you hear is from the ladies who are reading this for the first time). The cost is approximately \$11,000, but this does not include installation. We are praying that some of our men could volunteer their time and skills to help with this.
- 2) Hosting a family conference sponsored by Renewanation. Renewanation inspires and equips the family, church, and school to give children a biblical worldview. The cost of hosting the event will be approximately \$6,000.
- 3) Replacing the wooden bleachers in the gymnasium. This costly project will be split between the church, MCCA, and the Car Show fund. Each of the three parties will invest approximately \$25,000.


