Rules, Guidelines & Dress Code Agreement

Dear Parent and Camper:

We are excited and are anticipating a wonderful week that God will use to change lives and bring glory to Him. There has been a lot of prayer, planning, and preparation involved for this week, and we know that God has some great things He wants to happen while we are at Falls Creek.

Parents, at this time I would like to thank you for sharing your student with us for this week. We realize that you have entrusted in our care one of your most precious gifts from the Lord and in order to provide the very best and safest environment and welfare of each camper, we have a few guidelines that will need to be strictly enforced. All campers attending Falls Creek with the First Baptist Church of Elmore City will abide by these rules with no exceptions. Parents, we greatly need your help in this area. Please go over the following guidelines with your student and let them know that you are 100% supportive of these rules of Falls Creek and the measures that must be taken by sponsors to enforce them. Please pay special attention to the dress / attire rules. No exceptions will be made on these items. (Your child could be expelled from Falls Creek due to improper dress.)

- 1) No fireworks, firearms, motorcycles, or bicycles.
- 2) Alcohol, Drugs, Vapes, or tobacco products are strictly prohibited.
- 3) Rock throwing, water fights, water guns and shaving cream fights will not be permitted.
- 4) Campers will not be allowed to wear: tank tops, halter tops, spaghetti straps, translucent clothing, apparel that exposes the midriff, low cut tops or spandex apparel. (If you have to ask if it is too short, it is too short.)
- 5) Apparel displaying pictures, trademarks, or advertisement of tobacco, beer, alcoholic beverages, pubs, or any controlled substances are prohibited. Also any apparel displaying or insinuating anything obscene or indecent is prohibited.
- 6) Dresses and skirts must come to the knee. All shorts must be modest length. **NO BOXERS ARE TO BE WORN AS SHORTS—AT FALLS CREEK BOXERS ARE UNDERGARMENTS.**
- 7) Modest swimming suits are appropriate while swimming. A dark t-shirt must be worn over 2 piece swimming suits. Males should not wear tight fitting swim suits while going to and from the swimming areas. All campers must wear shoes; males must wear a t-shirt, and females must wear a long covering over their swim suits when leaving to go swim.
- 8) We expect campers to act in a respectful manner to all students, sponsors, and staff.
- 9) If any of these are violated, you will be contacted to immediately pick your child up at any time of day.

Parents, your support is welcomed and greatly appreciated! Above all else, please pray for each and every one of our campers during this special week.

2022 Parental Release Form

Please be on time so we can stay on schedule.

We understand and are in complete agreement that: There will be adults accompanying the Youth; and these adults will act in a parental role in our place.

**TRANSPORTATION WILL BE BY SCHOOL BUS / CHURCH VAN / OR VEHICLES
DRIVEN BY ACCOMPANYING ADULTS.**

If for any reason it becomes necessary to send our child home because of behavioral problems, we agree to come and pick our child up from this activity at our own expense.

AUTHORIZATION FOR MEDICAL CARE

In the event that our child becomes ill or injured while under the supervision of the FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF ELMORE CITY, or any of its leaders, we authorize him/her to receive First Aid and other emergency care. If it should become necessary for him/her to receive professional medical, surgical, or dental treatment, we authorize THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF ELMORE CITY and any of its leaders to give necessary "PARENTAL CONSENT" in our stead for a licensed physician, surgeon, or dentist to administer any medical, surgical or dental treatment that they deem necessary. We understand that every effort will be made to contact us immediately upon the discovery of the emergency. We further understand that we will take full financial responsibility for all expenses which may be incurred and that are not covered by FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF ELMORE CITY. This consent is given in advance of any specific diagnosis or treatment being required and to encourage those leaders who have temporary custody of our child and said physician, surgeon, or dentist to exercise their best judgment in situations deemed an emergency as to the requirements of such diagnosis of medical, surgical, or dental treatment. By signing this permission document, we acknowledge that we have had an opportunity to discuss all aspects of this activity, we fully understand the nature of these events and are in complete agreement and have no further questions regarding it. We give our consent for our child to participate, for the adults to act in a parental role in our place, and for him/her to receive emergency medical care as needed.

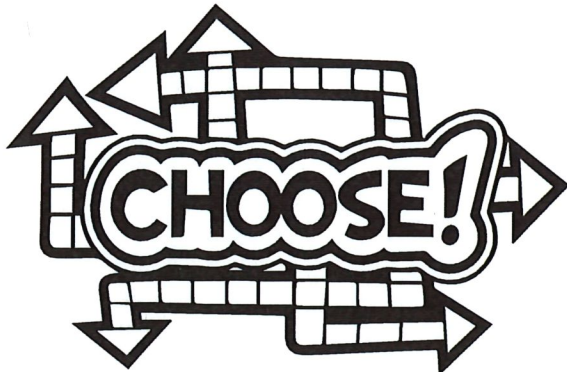

Falls Creek Youth Camp 2022 Student Release and Waiver of Claims Form (2 of 2)

I understand that it is the responsibility of my child's Host Church to obtain insurance permission for treatment or to limit my child's recreational activities because of a stated medical condition.

My child, _____ will be attending Falls Creek Youth Camp during the summer session, 2022. Falls Creek Conference Centers are managed and operated by the Baptist General Convention of Oklahoma ("Oklahoma Baptists"). In the event that my child should need emergency medical care or attention, the Host Church leadership, Oklahoma Baptists or any of their agents or employees is hereby authorized to consent to the provision of such emergency medical care, including without limitation, medical, dental, surgical care, or hospitalization, to my child as is recommended or suggested by a physician, nurse, surgeon, or other health care professional.

- If such emergency care is provided, I understand that my child's health insurance information will be given to the health care professional and that any expenses not covered by my insurance shall be my responsibility. I understand that the Host Church or Oklahoma Baptists will not be obligated to pay either the health care professional or me for any medical expenses incurred.
- There are instances when third party contractors are used to operate and supervise various events and activities. In those instances where third party contractors are used, I agree that neither the Host Church nor Oklahoma Baptists is responsible for the action of these third party contractors. I further agree that neither the Host Church nor Oklahoma Baptists is liable for the actions or activities of participants or sponsors participating in events or activities operated by third party contractors.
- I understand that the risk of injury from recreational activity is significant, including but not limited to, the potential for permanent paralysis and death. While particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist. I knowingly and freely assume all risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from negligence, and assume full responsibility for my child's participation in or observation of such recreational activity.
- Furthermore, in consideration of my child being allowed to attend Falls Creek Youth Camp, I, on behalf of myself and my child, hereby waive, and I hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Host Church, Oklahoma Baptists, their agents or employees, against any and all causes of action, rights, claims or suits which I or my child may have against the Host Church, Oklahoma Baptists, or their agents or employees as a result of injury to my child, including, but not limited to: (1) injuries arising from my child's participation in or observation of recreational activities at Falls Creek Youth Camp, and (2) injuries arising from the decision of the leadership of the Host Church, Oklahoma Baptists, or any of their agents or employees to consent to the provision of emergency medical care to my child.
- I understand that my child's image may be included in a video or in photographs that may be made during camp. I understand that a promotional or highlight video may be available for sale during and after camp. I consent that my child's image may appear on videos, promotional resources, camp endorsed web sites, etc.
- I give authority and permission to the Host Church, Oklahoma Baptists, and any of their staff or agents to inspect my child's belongings while at Falls Creek Youth Camp.
- I understand that Falls Creek Youth Camp is a place where many students seek counsel and advice from adult leaders, staff, counselors and others. I hereby consent to my child receiving spiritual and emotional counsel during their week of camp.
- I have received and read the Parent Information about Falls Creek Youth Camp including the list of the recreational options and the daily schedule, and I have received satisfactory answers to all my questions about such information. I have read the Falls Creek Youth Camp Code of Conduct and Dress Code, and I have discussed the Code of Conduct and dress code with my child.
