For those who are not participating in the trip in person, there is an opportunity to become involved through prayer and through monetary donations.

The Elders have established a special fund in order to receive donations towards the Guatemala Project Fund.

The Project Goal is \$16,825 and will be used towards the following:

- 5 Houses \$9,000
- 5 Stoves \$1,075
- Food Packs \$1,500
- Shoe Project \$1,250
- Bibles \$1,000
- Hygiene Kits \$1,000
- Luggage Expenses \$2,000
