1. Read John 10:22-42 together. What stands out to you from this passage? What questions come to mind? Was there anything in the sermon that impacted you?
2. Have you ever wrestled with the doctrine of election before? Below are a number of passages that clearly show God choosing people for himself. Read through them and talk about the implications:

 - 2 Timothy 1:9
 - Revelation 13:7-8
 - Romans 8:28-30

 - 2 Thessalonians 2:13

 - Revelation 17:8
3. What are some objections that come up when dealing with God choosing his sheep? Is it hard to hold the sovereignty of God and human free will in tension?
4. In what ways is the sovereignty of God in our salvation a comfort? In what ways does it lead to worship and praise of Jesus?
5. In verse 28-29 Jesus says that no one can snatch his sheep out of his hand, and no one can snatch his sheep out of the Father's hand. Have you ever wrestled with your assurance of salvation? How do these verses impact that?
6. Has your view of Jesus changed or grown as we've studied the gospel of John? In what ways? Has your faith grown as you've seen Jesus' miracles and teaching?
