Among the many fine gifts God has entrusted to The Chapel is that of hospitality. In 2018 the Anglican Diocese of Quincy approached The Chapel to request hospitality for a displaced fledgling hispanic mission it oversaw in Oak Cliff, led by Fr. Omar Bravo, a Mexican national educated for the Roman priesthood, but converted to Anglicanism. The name of the mission was then *Santisima Trinidad* —Holy Trinity.

After three years of ministry, and suffering from the dispersement caused by the pandemic, the mission requested local leadership and protection through The Reformed Episcopal Church mission efforts of REC100, and to become an extension work of The Chapel of the Cross, with a new, matching name—*Iglesia Santa Cruz*.

This request was granted by the rector, vestry, and diocese. The mission has now appointed officers, and meets monthly as a “pre-vestry” with myself as rector. In the Reformed Episcopal Church, works with fewer than twelve active communicants are known as “extension works,” and under the direction of the sponsoring rector and parish. Between twelve and twenty-nine they are named “mission works” and governed by a vicar and “Bishop’s Council.” Above twenty-nine they become regular parishes, with a rector and vestry.

Santa Cruz has about twenty-five communicants, and an average attendance of fifty souls. They hope to become an official mission this summer, and parish able to support its rector during 2023. Since organizing as a Chapel ministry, they have begun a choir, produced a Directory, and increased attendance, weekday catechesis offerings, and services. Members enjoy fellowship over lunch after their 1:00 pm service. *Santa Cruz* contributes to the “mother church” through a monthly offering toward utilities and by providing a thorough Saturday cleaning of all common areas (with STS students responsible for classrooms and offices).

Please pray for this ministry, which can also now be supported financially through its own page on The Chapel website. The Church can reach the nations by “going forth” through foreign missions—but also by welcoming the “stranger on our doorstep.” Hospitality is mission, and a wonderful ministry of our lovely homey parish! 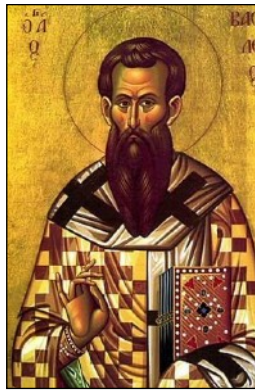

Work Hard — Clement of Alexandria

The duty of the Word is to supervise our instruction and discipline. Therefore, work hard and don't faint.... Just as there is one way of training philosophers, another for public speakers, and another for athletes, a certain character results from the training of Christ. Those who have been trained in this way become dignified above all else in their walk, their sitting at table, their food, their sleep, their going to bed, their regimen, and the rest of their way of life. For training guided by the Word is not too strained, but has the right tension.... Christ devotes Himself to watching for the favorable moment, reproving evil, exposing the causes of evil affections, and striking at the roots of



irrational lusts. He points out what we should abstain from and supplies salvation's antidote to the diseased.... How can we not acknowledge the Divine Instructor with the highest gratitude? He isn't silent, but discloses things that threaten to destroy us and instructs us in living righteously. Therefore, we must confess our deepest obligations to Him.... It is essential to think about human nature, to live as the truth directs, and to admire the Instructor and His counsel. These things are suitable and harmonious with each other. We must live a real life conforming ourselves to the image of the Instructor and making the Word and our deeds agree.
