When the search process has reached a point where they have chosen someone to be the next rector they will notify the bishop who will arrange for the position to be offered to the candidate. If the candidate accepts the position, it will be announced on an agreed Sunday morning both here and in the candidate's parish or other place of employment. Due to the confidentiality of the process, there is no further information to share at this point.
