Dear Parent/Guardian:

Miller Evangelical Christian Union Church, located at 1110 President Street, Brooklyn, NY 11225, is actively accepting registration for their Summer Program.

DATE OF PROGRAM: Monday, July 5, 2022 to Friday, August 12, 2022

HOURS: 7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.

AGES: Kindergarten to 5th Grade

COSTS: \$175/per week with a registration fee of \$35 (non-refundable).

PLANNED ACTIVITIES: Bible teaching, Tutoring, field trips, arts/craft/games, trips to places of interest (Museums, Parks, Aquarium, Zoo, etc)

Please note: the costs for the trips are not included in the weekly fee. We will make every effort to schedule trips that are free or at minimal costs. You will be notified whenever a trip is planned sufficient notice, so that we can obtain the necessary permission form for your child/children to participate.

Our goal is to provide a program, fully supervised in a safe, spiritual and enjoyable environment.

REGISTRATION: All registration should be completed by Friday, June 10, 2022. This includes submission of application, consent form and a copy of your child's most recent medical information, the non-refundable registration fee of \$35.00 and the first week's fee of \$175.00.

PAYMENT: Once you have enrolled your child in the program, you are required to make weekly payments in advance. In other words, you will always be paying for the upcoming week. If payment is not received your child will not be able to attend and you run the risk of losing your slot.

There will be NO REFUNDS. The payment rate is: \$175/week for 6 weeks



MEALS: A light breakfast will be provided in the mornings. We are planning to get lunch through the Lunch Program administered by the Board of Education. We ask that you provide a light snack for the afternoon. Please put snack in a container with the child's name.

BEHAVIOR: There will be no unnecessary running around, disrespect to staff or other camp members (including talking about their family), no unnecessary noise, no cursing, no radios. Children are expected to follow the rules of the camp, listen to their teachers and do what they are instructed to do. The staff is dedicated to treating your child with the utmost respect and care. If a child continually violates the rules, you will be notified and a conference, with the child's parent(s) or guardian, will be set up to determine proper action. If the behavior does not improve, the child will be dismissed from the program.

TRIPS: We will be planning trips that are enjoyable and educational and whenever possible at little or no cost. As you know the cost of trips are not included in the weekly fee. Some of the places we will visit include:
