

## Make reading a part of your summer fun--Visit the Church Library!

The library contains a wide variety of materials -- biblical reference and history, commentaries, devotions, Christian living, and religious and regular fiction for adults and children. The library is open on Sundays from 9:30 to 11:00 am and from 5:30-8:00 pm during Vacation Bible School, June 26-29 or by appointment (Sharon Mackintosh 803 359-2407). The Library is located on the second floor of the educational building down from the balcony choir, directly above the pre-school offices. Books and videos may be checked out for two weeks and renewed. To return, drop them back in the library (and check out some more!) or in the box outside the door when the library is closed.

**SUMMER READING PROGRAM: JUNE 19 - AUGUST 7 -** The program is open to ages 18 months to the 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Parents may read books to young non-readers. Prizes will be awarded on August 14 to each child completing the program by reading 10 non-chapter books, five chapter books, or a combination. We have a large selection of early reader and chapter book series to enjoy.

**REMINDER:** Please check through your books to see if you or your child have returned all that are due to the Church Library. 

Prime Time Adults: Adults 55 and older meet monthly for food, fellowship and fun. This group is a wonderful mix of people who also travel for day and overnight trips.

Junior High (6th, 7th & 8th grades) & Senior High Youth (9th - 12th grades): meet regularly for planned activities
