Pentecost: Transforming Power Elder Team Member | Emily Payne June 5, 2022

Step 1: <u>Believe</u> in Jesus: John 14:11 – believe that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, at the very least believe that the works He does in His Father's name convince you.

Step 2: Love Jesus: John 14:15 – really love him, you keep and obey His commands.

Step 3: Jesus asks the Father to give you Holy Spirit to remain in you forever: John 14:16.

Why do we need the Holy Spirit?

Luke 24:49: "And now I will send the Holy Spirit, just as my Father promised. But stay here in the city until the Holy Spirit comes and fills you with <u>power</u> from heaven."

Power = Dunamis

1: Strength, power, ability

Inherent power, power <u>residing in</u> a thing by virtue of its nature, or which a person exerts and puts forth

Power for performing miracles

More power and excellence of soul

Power consisting in or resting upon <u>armies</u>, <u>forces</u>, <u>hosts</u>

Comforter, Counselor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengthener, Standby.

The Father sends Holy Spirit in Jesus's name – in His place to represent Jesus and act on His behalf.

He will <u>teach you all things</u>. He will cause you to <u>remember</u> everything that Jesus tells us.
