Missionaries serving in Bolivia

Who's Feeding You?: One of my main jobs as a missionary is to train others, especially those who are preparing to serve the Lord with their lives. As I have mentioned before, the longer we are in the ministry here, this becomes a bigger part of what we do and where we invest the most of our time. While there are many lessons and Bible principles that I try to share with them, one of the most important is probably teaching them to be self feeders and self growers. So here are a few ideas that can help to get to this point of maturity and be a self feeder.

There is also a great lack of biblical knowledge and the principles that would apply even if they recognized their error.
