"It's amazing how quickly a group of strangers can turn into a family. Words cannot express how sad we are to part with this incredible place. Each and every one of you were such a significant part in making this week one of the best we've all had in a while. So we wanted to say thank



you, the biggest we can to all of you! Thank you for opening your hearts and your home to us, and to any other backpacker in general. Thank you for spending time with us, getting to know us, teaching us and welcoming us. Thank you for feeding us... Thank you for making us feel at home and so welcomed to the family. Thank you for the conversations, the memories, the home away from home, the love, the family, the time, the dedication, the knowledge, the patience, the bread and so so so much more! And finally, thank you all for being you, and for making this place so special. So friends, stay in touch, keep doing all the amazing things you're doing, and know you all have a home in a few new cities in Israel!"

It takes a team to create a home environment such as this where the Holy Spirit can work, and our guests know that we do what we do because of the gospel. It takes a team to make meals together, clean and make beds together, spend time with Israelis together, and most importantly, to share the gospel together. While one person is sharing the gospel with an Israeli during a meal, everyone else at the ministry is supporting them in that conversation by cooking the meal, cleaning the dishes and kitchen, and serving tea or dessert.

A team of volunteers is vital in sharing the gospel with our Israeli guests, which is why we need people who will volunteer with us this upcoming season from October to February.
