Three Identity Building Statements

1. Statement of _____ - "This is My Son"

- The Father focuses on who Jesus is, not on what Jesus does.
- Our culture bases one's identity and worth upon achievement, something external. That's wrong.
- Our kids should not earn their _____ from what they do. They are valued and validated for who they are, our children.
- If our kids don't get acceptance from us, they go somewhere else to get it.
- We accept our children, but we don't accept _____ attitudes and behavior (Hebrews 12:5-6 says the acceptance of the child is connected to the discipline of the child.) Discipline is performed with the fruit of the Spirit for the welfare of the child vs. punishment which is performed out of anger because the parent is agitated.

2. Statement of _____ - "... whom I love"

- _____ your love - say "I love you."
- Know your child's love languages – acts of service, gifts, quality time, words of affirmation, physical touch.


- Show appropriate, _____ affection
