Hi all,

In preparation for the PC meeting tomorrow evening, I enclose the usual Financial Update as of 31st May 2022.

As you will see from the numbers, this is quite good news, and I add some brief detailed comments:

- 1. Envelope Donations (Collections) are up over \$6 k, offset by \$4 k drops in Pre-Authorized Debit and Canada Helps - as congregations slowly increase;
- 2. Rents for Parking Spots are down \$2 k (POV is OK);
- 3. All staff salaries are below budget, thanks to a "holiday" from Jan-June in Benefits Costs;
- 4. Salaries as of the 30th April Report were overstated due to a bookkeeping error (not picked up then);
- 5. Our Operating Expense were down \$14 k (5%), leaving our Operating Deficit down \$13 k (11%);
- 6. Major Projects were way below budget as we await the Permit for the Lower Hall Elevator, and were almost offset by our regular Investment Income;
- 7. Our YTD Net Cash Flow was thus \$73 k better than planned (59%), but this will be corrected by Dec;
- 8. A regular \$22,500 per month (\$270,000 per year) draw from our investments has been set up for the rest of this year we need to work hard on 2023 if we are not to exhaust our accumulated assets!
