Teachers and students at Hawkins STEM Academy are engaged in **Project Based Learning (PBL)**. In PBL, students develop research questions related to real-world work issues, then find resources and gather information. Students and teachers reflect on what they have learned, share feedback, and present project results to people with job and life experience related to the project.
