

Behind our personality lies primal instincts and patterns of how we function in this world at a foundational level. In enneagram terms, we call these patterns “subtypes.” Different from Enneagram type structure, subtypes offer us wisdom on the 3 instinctual, and often unconscious, ways we tend to orient to the environment around us in order to keep ourselves alive and safe. The subtypes: sexual, social, and self preservation are “stacked” in order of innate importance for our basic human needs and values. They are truly the unconscious drivers of much of our decision making in this world.

In this workshop, we will grow a deeper understanding of instinctual subtypes, recognizing how they show up in our every day lives and relationships.
