



Family Worship Guide- July 11-16

"Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ." - 1 Corinthians 11:1

Pray this week each day for Kenya: is predominantly Christian, but several tribal groups in the north remain largely unreached, and much of the coastal region is predominantly Muslim. Additionally, in the region known as Greater Somalia in northeastern Kenya, 90 percent of the population is ethnically Somali and fervently Muslim. In these areas, Christian missionaries from other parts of Kenya and converts from Islam are often attacked and have been killed. There are some churches in these regions, but their activities are severely limited by the local communities. The Kenyan constitution grants every citizen freedom of religion, but local governments in resistant areas are led by Muslim officials who do little to protect the rights of believers.

MONDAY-

- Read back over Sermon Listening Guide and Scripture from yesterday Sermon. What did the Lord lay on your heart during the sermon?
- Work on memorizing 1 Corinthians 11:1
- Pray through Psalm 11, 41, 71, 101, 131
- Pray for
 - Who's Your One?
 - Richmond- Pray for our city leaders; our schools; for Crosspoint to be a light for the gospel
 - Crosspoint Church to Thrive in sharing the gospel as VBS begins tonight
 - Kenya:
 - Pray for believers who are targeted by a terrorist group in northeastern Kenya.
 - Pray for a Somali Christian family who returned to their community to share the gospel.
 - Pray for front-line workers in northern Kenya who are under continual threat of attack.
 - Pray for Pastor Galgalo, and pray that God will raise up more full-time ministry workers.
 - Pray for Abdiwelli's widow and sons as they learn to overcome fear and forgive his killers.

TUESDAY-

- Look over your sermon listening guide and respond to the truth the Lord has revealed to you.
- Work on memorizing 1 Corinthians 11:1
- Read back over 1 Corinthians 11:2-16
- Choose a Psalm to pray: Psalm 12, 42, 72, 102, 132
- Pray for
 - VBS taking place tonight
 - Ukraine- Pray that Ukrainians ultimately would hope not in governments, elections or diplomacy, but in Jesus Christ. Ask God to deliver Ukraine from evil. May He have mercy and heal this land. May He give Ukraine peace and the chance to develop as a nation that values truth, justice and freedom, all rooted in the goodness of God.

WEDNESDAY -

- Read 1 Corinthians 11
- Choose a Psalm to pray: Psalm 13, 43, 73, 103, 133
- Pray for
 - VBS
 - Kenya: 78 percent of Kenyans are Christians, including 48 percent evangelicals. However, parts of the country have a Muslim majority with significant Islamist activity and influence. Islamic extremists are most active in the north and east, and their activities extend to Nairobi in the south. In the coastal areas, community members and local governments also persecute Christians.

THURSDAY -

- Pray through Psalm 14, 44, 74, 104, 134
- Pray about who you can invite to Crosspoint gatherings and find opportunities to invite them.
- Pray for
 - VBS and that kids who are not Christians would respond to the gospel
 - Who's Your One?
 - Ukraine: Pray that the evangelical church will remain united, even as it faces difficult questions, such as how involved believers ought to be in politics or in armed conflict.
 - Crosspoint Families and Family Ministry

FRIDAY -

- Read 1 Corinthians 11:17 - 34
- Pray for Crosspoint's vision for 2022, that we would Thrive in serving together.
- Pray through a Psalm 15, 45, 75, 105, 135
- Pray for VBS Family Night and that parents would respond to the gospel
- Pray for Christians in Kenya: Christians cannot openly discuss their faith in areas with a Somali majority or areas near the northern border without risk of losing their family, livelihood and standing in their community. There is a significant threat of violence against Christian converts in Somali-majority areas. In eastern Kenya, the al-Shabab Islamist terrorist group attacks Christians, bombing churches and killing believers. In Muslim-majority areas along the coast, Christians are rejected by their families and communities.

SATURDAY - reminder that worship begins tomorrow at 10am!!

- Pray for Crosspoint vision, that we would Thrive in our walk with God
