

God won't solve all of our problems, but God is with us every moment of the day as we work through them. Sometimes there are solutions and sometimes there aren't. God walks us through those valleys. In the words of 1 Peter, "Cast all your anxiety on him, because he cares for you."

As a person prone to worrying, I need to hear those words daily. A friend once sent me a quotation when I was fretting about something outside my control. It was something like, "I have had a great many troubles in my life, and some of them have actually happened." So whether your anxieties are very real and hard or you struggle with the "what ifs," God stands firm. Cast your burdens upon Jesus. Lean into the Savior. Most of the storms will subside and whatever the outcome, we can know with sure and certain hope God will be on the other side since God was there each step of the way.

As you leave your burdens with God and work to set the storms of life aside, at least for a little while, may you feel the gentle rain on your shoulders or the sun on your face. May you see the blue sky and hear birds sing in the new leaves on the trees. God's creation is a wonder to behold. God's presence and hope are real – it might be time to cast aside our fears and dance in the rain.
