June was the weakest month of 2022 for donations to our General Fund, with donations almost \$15,000 less than our budget. Even though expenses were much less than budgeted, we had a deficit of \$5,400 for the month, and a deficit of almost \$35,000 for our shortened fiscal "year" of January through June. Our General Fund balance ends the year almost \$11,000 in the red. (Normal fiscal year-end adjustments still need to be made.)

An initial cost-cutting step is to reduce the summer hours of our church office, effective tomorrow, July 18. Watch for an announcement on the shortened office hours, which should reduce our costs by \$800 - \$1,000 each month. (Our pastors work times are not reduced.) However, the significant issue is that giving for the past six months was down 24% from the same months in 2021. Please pray for God's direction on what we should do to return our financial state to a healthy balance.


