- The Modern Missionary Age, 1793 1900 A.D. A man by the name of William Carey was so burdened in 1793 for the lost in India that he became one of the first modern missionaries. Men like Jonathan Edwards began what's known as the Great Awakening in North America. Other missionaries went to Central and South America, Australia, and Asia. In the span of a few hundred years the church spread faster than any other time since the first century.
