CONCLUSION

"The letter to the Church at Pergamos teaches us about the disobedient act of compromise, being tempted to achieve personal advancement by partnering with the ungodly. We're to be reminded that as a church we're "engaged to Christ" and must be kept pure (2 Corinthians 11:1-4). Later in Revelation this present world system is pictured as a defiled harlot, while the church is presented as a pure bride. The congregation or the individual Christian that compromises with the world just to avoid suffering or achieve success is committing "spiritual adultery" and being unfaithful to the Lord."
