New Curriculum: Children K-5



What does spiritual growth look like for a kid? Our new Sunday School series, *Grow Kids*, thinks about it in terms of four spiritual habits. To help a kid grow spiritually, teach them to spend time with God, spend time with others, use their gifts, and share their story.

WEEK 3: Kids will hear about the time Peter and John shared the Gospel, even when it was dangerous. THE BIG IDEA: We can share God's story. THE BIBLE: Acts 4:1-20; I John 3:18.

WEEK 4: We will talk about the time Jesus washed his disciples' feet and showed them what it means to serve. THE BIG IDEA: We can serve others. THE BIBLE: John 13:1-17, 34-35; Romans 12:3-8.
