#### Let us be Kind to One Another

There has been an increase in COVID-19 transmission in New Brunswick over the past two weeks. COVID-19 incidence in the province has increased from 60 cases per 100,000 to 129 cases per 100,000. The provincial PCR positivity rate has doubled from approx. 10% to 20%. We are encouraged to maintain safe health practices. Proof of Covid vaccination is not required. Some folks may choose to wear a mask and maintain physical distance. The offering plate remains at the back. Hand sanitizer is available. ## Steeple Campaign Launch July 18, 7 pm

You are invited to a special event! On Monday, July 18, at 7 pm on the lawn by St. Luke's Church, Woodstock, the Launch of the Fundraising campaign for the Steeple Repair Project will take place. This special event marks the beginning of a program to raise \$53,000 to repair a section of damaged frame at the first roof line and replace all of the roofing on the entire Steeple structure. It also includes needed repair to a portion of the rock wall foundation of the church on the northeast corner of the structure. The program will last about thirty minutes and include information about current activities at the church, a brief review of the historical significance of the building and its contents, and an overview of the specific repairs that require immediate attention.
