Dining Hall Project Update July 2022



Happy Summer Daybreak Community,

I pray that everyone is having a great and enjoyable summer so far. It is great to have camps back on the island and use this opportunity to share Christ with youth. These have been challenging times, but we pray that God uses this camping season for His glory!

It has been a couple months since the Fundraising Banquet, and I wanted to give everyone an update on where things stand. At the banquet this year we outlined our plan to build a new Dining Hall at camp where the current one is situated. We laid out the timing and what is required to get this project started. I thank you for praying for this venture, and ask that you continue to keep on praying for it as we go through the camping season and into next year. I mentioned at the banquet that we are asking the camp community to prayerfully consider how you may play a part in our Dining Hall project. Obviously paying for a project of this size is considerable, and as I mentioned in May, this will be the biggest project that Daybreak Point Bible Camp will take on in most of our lifetimes. We estimate the cost of the Dining Hall to be at least \$5,000,000, and we want to start the demolition of the current Dining Hall at the end of next year's camping season (September 2023).

With that being said, we are in the need of some immediate resources to keep this project moving ahead. In the next few months, we are getting all the consulting work done. This includes survey, structural, mechanical, electrical, etc. engineering so that we can get ready for the permitting process. We will require some funds to pay for that, but I am also asking our community at large if you have the skills and certification (and would be interested in providing some of these services for this endeavour for your usual fees) we would love to hear from you.

In the next month we will have the website for the dining hall project up and running and there will be more ongoing information available.
