

- Small toys such as balls and Frisbees
- notebooks
- pencil crayons
- markers
- puzzles
- hair ties
- stickers
- backpacks (need 10)
- large reusable grocery bags (need 4),
- wash clothes (need 16),
- bath towels (need 16)
- clotheslines with clips (need 5)
- plastic camping dishes must flatten for packing
- bowls, strainers
- mixing and serving spoons
- cutlery
- bars of soap (need 10)
- toothbrushes, toothpaste, dental floss
- shampoos and conditioner (can be family size for family use)
- lotions
- Band-Aids, tensor, antiseptic pads (or small first aid kits with the same for each house) (need 5)
