What Else Do We Need?

Let's just acknowledge the truth – people can be stubborn. And since everyone reading (or writing) this fits the category of *people*, we can simply admit that we all struggle with some degree of stubbornness. And please do not misunderstand my intent, conviction is not a bad quality. It is foundational in Christianity.

But what happens when conviction clashes with the reality of Jesus? There is an interesting discussion in John 10.22-30. The people *appear* to be looking for something straightforward from Jesus. However, was that really what they desired? Jesus made it clear that He had already *plainly* declared His identity. He pointed to His works as evidence.

During the lesson today, I want to challenge us to consider Jesus. What more would you need before giving your life to Him? Is the issue a lack of evidence on God's part, or rather that we may just not desire the outcome and path of that evidence?

5th Sunday Singing: Next Sunday, July 31st at 6 pm at the Ringgold congregation.



Education Kickoff: Our kickoff for our new Bible classes will be Sunday, August 14th. Please make plans to attend as we begin new classes for the year.


