

"UPDATE" MARK BEACH IS GOING HOME

Hello Friends!

Yesterday I got to go home for a visit!

It was my first time back in Brantford in 15 months. It wasn't a long visit. In total, I was home for about an hour. We tested out all our home equipment which was mainly the chair lift, the patient lift, the bed, and a few other small things. Everything worked perfectly and the OT that went with us gave her approval! And so this means...I'm being discharged and coming home on Tuesday, August 9th!

Theresa and I are both so excited about this but we are also aware of the challenges ahead as we adjust to a new stage of this journey we are on. We can't do it alone and so we'll have wound care, nursing care, and physio at home along with help from family and friends. Tuesday will be bittersweet for us. We will be so happy to leave the hospital itself but we are going to miss the people, some of whom have been with us since day one. We have gotten to know some of the nurses and staff really well and they've been such a big part of our lives and it'll be hard to say goodbye. But hopefully, we'll get a chance to say pass by them in the halls and say hello on Monday, Wednesday, & Friday each week as we'll be back at St. Joe's for dialysis.

Please continue to pray for Theresa and me as I recover at home. We consider prayer essential in the healing process.
