Music Team

The Music Team serves on the Central Youth Team and works under the supervision of the Youth Director/Pastor. Their role is to organize and lead the worship team in the worship portion of youth nights.

- **ENGAGE:** You'll intentionally reach out to teenagers -- going to them before they come to us.
- **PLAY:** You'll carry the attitude of inviting, celebrating, and affirming students.
- **GUIDE:** You'll be responsible for shepherding the spiritual journey of each member of your small group, helping them take next steps that draw them closer to Christ.
- **PRAY:** You'll pray personally, for your students, and with your students.

- Come prepared
- Make all students feel welcomed
- Celebrate what is good
- Participate wholeheartedly
