**The Power of Grace  
Titus 2:11-15**

In the Christian life, God calls us to live differently than the world, and to glorify God through it. How is that possible? It's not simply a matter of setting our mind to doing right, improving ourselves, or just changing our behavior. Neither can we live an authentic Christian life and think we will stay the same. When we fail to understand the primary way of growth, we end up feeling overwhelmed, discouraged, or prideful. What is the key to living the life that pleases God? Living in the grace of God. Today we want to see how the grace of God transforms us into the people God created us to be.
