

NOTES

A. The Power of His Hand: (vs.10)

- Waters in the hollow of His hand (vs.12)
- Dust (earth) in a basket
- Mountain placed on scales
- Spreads the heavens- canopy (vs.22, 26)

KEY: "He sits enthroned above the circled of the earth." (vs.22) "The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth." (vs.28)

B. The Mind of the Lord: (vs.13-14,)

- Do you think you can teach Him anything; instruct Him in something He does not understand?

KEY: *Do you think He does not understand your situation? (vs. 27-28)*

C. Our Loving Shepherd: (vs.11)

- Tends His flock (see Ps.23)
- Gathers & leads His lambs

KEY: "He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. (vs.28-29)

III. The Application: (Isa 40:30-31)

"Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall."

But those who wait on the Lord: will renew their strength.

Wait: hope, trust, put their faith in....

- **They will soar on wings like eagles**
 - Soar above their situations
 - Catch the upper draft (Holy Spirit)
- **they will run and not grow weary**
 - Will finish the race set before them (Marathon)
 - Will not run out of strength
- **they will walk and not be faint.**
 - Will not fall; not collapse
 - Will not be taken out...

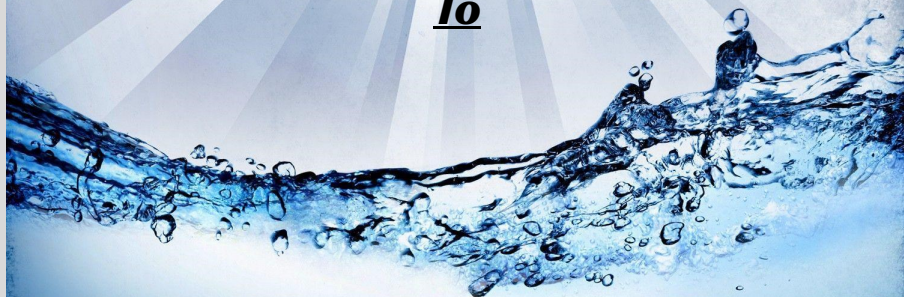

- An amazing prophecy.
- A confused people.
- The desperate need for hope!

- They will return to Israel.

B. The King is coming: (vs.3-5)

- Promise of the Messiah
- Preparing the way

C. Who will you trust? (vs.6-9)

- All men are like grass (dry up and fade away)
- Nations are like a drop in a bucket (vs. 15-17; 23-24)

"To whom will you compare God? (vs. 18)
