Congresswoman Marcy Kaptur

Rep. Marcy Kaptur, a native Toledoan, represents Ohio's 9th District in Congress. Elected in 1983 to this position she is the longest serving woman in the history of the U.S. House of Representatives and the second longest serving woman in the entire Congress behind former U.S. Senator Barbara Mikulski of Maryland. She is the daughter of Anastasia Delores and Stephen Jacob Kaptur. Her parents were both of Polish descent. Her mother was an automobile union organizer and

her family operated a small grocery store. Kaptur started volunteering in politics at the age of 13.

She graduated from St. Ursula Academy and became the first person in her family to attend college. Kaptur served on the Toledo-Lucas County Planning Commission and was Director of Planning for the National Center for Urban Ethnic Affairs. She later served as a Domestic Policy Advisor for President Jimmy Carter. Rep. Kaptur was first elected in 1982 beating her opponent 58-39%. From 1986 and following she has won each election with at least 74% of the vote. In 1996 Ross Perot asked Marcy to be his Vice-Presidential running mate. She declined.

Among Congresswoman Kaptur's achievements in Congress are the Restoring America's Leadership in Innovation Act to strengthen inventors' property rights and the World War II Memorial Act, authorizing the American Battle Monuments Commission to establish a World War II Memorial. She also helped lead the American Clean Energy and Security Act to help protect the Great Lakes Region.
