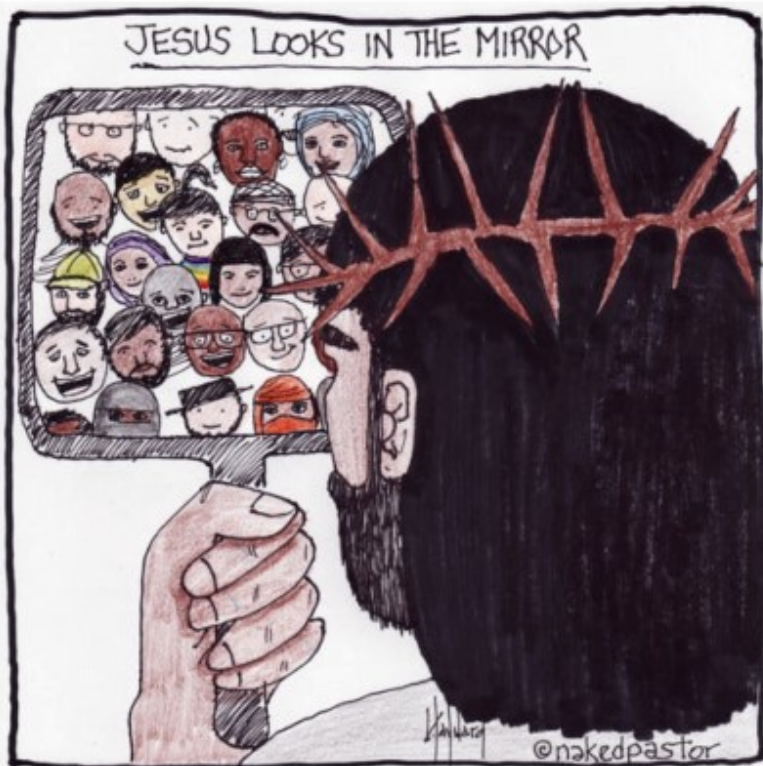

Sunday, September 25th will be **Orange Shirt Sunday** across the Parish of the Valley. All members of the parish are invited to wear orange on that day as we share in the important work of repentance, truth telling and reconciliation across Canada.

This year we are inviting all members of our area parish to designate the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, **Tuesday October 4th, as a Day of Prayer and Fasting for Peace**. Members of the parish are invited to take time on the day to pray for peace in our world, thinking especially of the ongoing war in Ukraine. We are also invited, each in our own way, to offer loving service on that day to further the cause of peace in our local communities. On the evening of October 4th, St. John's Eganville, St. Stephen's Micksburg, St. Paul's Cobden and Holy Trinity Pembroke will all be open between 6:30pm and 8:30pm for prayers for peace led by members of our clergy team and licensed lay readers.
