Romans 6:1-23

Anytime there is a clear explanation of the Gospel there is a natural question that arises...can we just sin?

Answer: No, you are dead to sin. / Romans 6:2

were baptized INTO Christ
baptizo - fully wet, immersed
baptized into His death
raised to walk "in newness of life"
You died to sin upon justification
No longer a slave to sin
Christ died one time and no more
Death no longer has dominion over Him
Jesus died to sin but is alive to God

- Vs 11 "Likewise, reckon ye also yourselves"
- We are to consider ourselves dead to sin but alive to God / think that way
- "Let not" Neither yield" / choice to not be a slave with your body
- Sin can reign in the body not the spirit
- Vs 17-18 "ye were the servants of sin...ye became the servants of righteousness."

what happened?? Vs 17 "But ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you."
