

II. The Work of the Suffering Servant?

A. Who am I?

Isa 53:6 "We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity (sin) of us all." NIV

B. Why He died?

1. John's Words:

Jn 1:29-30 "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" NKJV

2. One Without Sin:

Isa 53:6 "...and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity (sin) of us all."

Isa. 53:8 "...for the transgression (sin) of my people he was stricken."

Isa 53:11 "...and he will bear their iniquities."

Isa 53:12 "For he bore the sin of many..."

3. Vicarious/Substitutional Atonement:

* **Notice:** it is written in past tense ("was") 700 years before the event.
Isa 53:5 "But he was **pierced** for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed."

Application: We have **both** a

(1) Suffering Savior

(2) Coming King

* For all Believers- both Israel and the World

Isa. 52:15 "So will he sprinkle (startle) many nations, and kings will shut their mouths because of him. (Awe!)

For what they were not told, they will see, and what they have not heard, they will understand." NIV

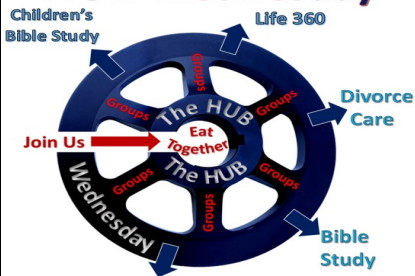

Scriptures: Isaiah 52:13-53:12

History: "Isaiah Scroll" (Dead Sea Scrolls)
Oldest Isaiah manuscript
Isaiah 53 found

How can we understand this Isaiah 53?
Acts 8:30-35 Ethiopian Eunuch
- Philip understood and explained it.

Modern day Rabbis reject this is Jesus.
This must mean the Jews (Israel)
Note: 'he/his' referred to 49 times.

I. Who is the Suffering Servant? (Isa. 52:13)

A. How He is described?

- Before suffering:** (Isa. 53:2)
 - Like a tender shoot
 - Root out of dry ground
 - No beauty or majesty
 - He was despised and rejected by men (Isa. 53:3)
 - Not an attractive, charismatic man...
- After suffered:**
 - Appalled, disfigured. (Isa. 52:14; 50:6)
 - Oppressed and afflicted
 - Silent (prophetic) like a lamb. (Isa. 53:7)

B. Excruciatingly Death:

- His death:** (Isa. 53:8-9, 10)
 - Cut off from the land of the living— crushed, bruised, beaten, whipped, pierced
 - Assigned a grave (rich man) ...prophetic.
- Resurrected:** (Isa. 53:10-11)
"He enjoyed a long life...sees all this accomplished..."
