We will also be sharing a tradition that began in 1951 called **Corsage for Missions** that day. The custom is to purchase a ribbon or “corsage” and pin it on the shoulder of someone you care about or want to honor. We will have a variety of ribbons for you to purchase.

Corsage for Mission is a way to show double love and caring. Not only is this a way to show someone in our congregation that we love and honor them but also that we can bless people around the world. The proceeds from our corsage sale go to **feed a hungry child**, provide medicine for the sick, education for children and youth, shelter for the homeless, and to spread the good news of Jesus.
