He is helping to teach a three week workshop on the Psalms to 26 national translators (including Doku translator Jimmy). After that he will continue to work with Jimmy on Genesis, and then participate in the 100 day "memorial service" for Joseph on Nov 27. Paul will return to Canada on Dec 3.

We are thankful that Jimmy has only grown in his resolve to translate the Doku Bible after Joseph's passing. He is in the middle of representing the "vision" in five regional centres in the Doku area. Please pray for him in this!

We are thankful Cathy was able to go to Calgary to participate in some face-to-face meetings with the Wycliffe Canada member care team she serves remotely through "data administration". She was also able to spend some time with her parents, staying at their place.
