Romans 1:16,17

Four words that Paul gives us in **Romans 1** that are critical to understanding the Gospel:

1. **Power** – **Romans 1:16** says the Gospel "...is the **power** of God..."

2. **Salvation** – **Romans 1:16** "...that brings **salvation**..."

3. **Believe** – **Romans 1:16** "...to everyone who **believes**..."

4. **Righteousness** – **Romans 1:17** "...For in the gospel the **righteousness** of God is revealed..."

Faith activates God's **POWER** that brings **SALVATION** by **BELIEVING** in the finished work of Jesus, and in that sovereign act, the **RIGHTEOUSNESS** of God is revealed.
