# **CONNECTION**

Last week we looked at Jesus inviting people to "Come & See". When
was the last time someone invited you to come and see something that was
unfamiliar to you. Did it go well, how did you feel, etc.?

#### **OPENING PRAYER**

### **SCRIPTURE:**

• John 2: 1-12

#### **CONVERSATIONS:**

- Share the most memorable wedding story (that isn't your own).
- Read John 2:1-5
  - Mary doesn't tell Jesus how to solve the problem of being out of wine but just trusts it to him. Share a time where you left a problem in your life to Jesus and how he cared for you in that season? What did Jesus ask you to do? (i.e. wait, apologize, repent, pray, etc.)
- Read John 2:6 11
  - What did the six stone jars of water represent? What did Jesus turning the water into wine represent?
  - This first sign of Jesus was that he had come to do something new to introduce a new people (the church) and a new covenant (through his death and resurrection).
    - If the new people of God is the church, what are the implications for the Jewish people?
    - In what ways does the church have the same calling that the Jewish people once had? (Compare Isaiah 42:5 7 and Matthew 5:14 16)
    - In what ways is the church different from the people of Israel?
  - How is the covenant that God had with Israel different from the covenant that God has with the church through Jesus?



 If Jesus came to fulfill and complete the original (old) covenant, does that mean that the old covenant was bad? Why or why not?

- Read Mark 2:22.
  - What happens if we try to pour the new wine into old wineskins?
  - What are the dangers of mixing and matching between the old covenant and the new covenant?
  - Is the Old Testament still relevant for believers today? Should we still study the Old Testament?
- Jesus' sign was not only that he was going to do something new, but that it would be lavish.
  - What would cause someone not to see how lavish or extravagant something was?
  - Where have you seen God's lavish grace in your life?
