#### Is it really 2 months ago that we returned from Canada??

What a blessing that we had our interns and faithful workers here in Mongolia that allowed us to have the freedom to go to Canada.

It has certainly been a whirlwind since we've returned. We arrived back to our grafting and harvest season and a revolving door of guests.

This month we celebrated Canadian Thanksgiving and we truly have so many things to be thankful for. One of the things we are most thankful for is the growing sense of COMMUNITY among our workers. We planned our annual Fall Staff Picnic and when we were sitting

around in the ger enjoying the bountiful food we asked the workers to share things they were thankful for. One thing that they all mentioned was the co-operative vegetables that we grew. This was a new thing we started this year. We planted potatoes, carrots, beets, turnips, cabbage, onions, cucumbers, tomatoes, and peppers that we then divided between the workers.

In a month we have to say good-bye to our Interns, Terrell & Christiana who have helped with social media, construction and teaching English. In September we celebrated our 40th wedding anniversary and will add a week on to our trip to Turkey, for the Multiply conference, to celebrate.
