

DIOCESE ANNOUNCEMENT

Bishop Townshend has accepted the request of the Reverend Jenny Sharp to retire effective December 31, 2022. Jenny was ordained a deacon in May 2008 and priested in March of 2009. She served the parishes of Church of the Ascension, London, Christ Church, Camlachie and St. John-in-the-Wilderness, Brights Grove before moving to the Diocese of Nova Scotia and PEI. In 2017, Jenny returned to the Diocese of Huron as the rector of St. James, St. Marys, the position from which she is retiring. She has served on the Postulancy Board, as Co-Chair of the Companion Diocese Relationship Committee, on Diocesan council and as the Regional Dean of Perth. Jenny will be honoured with the other retirees at Synod.
