Original Word: xáris - is preeminently used of the Lord's unmerited favor – freely extended to give Himself away to people

"TRUTH"

Original Word: alétheia "Not" + "Concealed", reality, sincerity, truth in the moral sphere, divine truth revealed to man, straightforwardness.
