Missionary Corner



Since my campus ministry to students in Edmonton has started up again near the middle of August, work has been busy and fun. Since the restrictions had mostly been lifted last year on campus, much of the work in 2021 had been building back up the ministry and sharing widely with teams that we had not met in 2 years.

This year though, my team and I

made a goal to go deeper with the abundance of new students we have been in contact with. From the beginning of the year, our goal was to establish 10 small groups within the ministry that would meet regularly throughout the year, aside from weekly gathering on Monday night. This could be a Bible study, chapel group, or even prayer group. So far, we have managed to get 8 of these groups up and running with two volleyball teams, one basketball team, one hockey, two football, and two soccer teams. I am truly amazed at the way God has organized these groups to further the mission of sharing with students, athletes, and leaders on campus the good news of Jesus. A prayer for the student ministry would be for our staff- including me. We are all quite tired and exhausted at this point in the year. With a small team of 3, there are many needs and not enough time to give one on one discipleship at times to students who are struggling.

Another update, this one being more so on the sad side, is that the professional soccer team I had been volunteering with as a chaplain for the last 5 seasons ended up going bankrupt and has made the hard decision to not play in the CPL (Canadian Premier League) next year. This is especially devastating to the players and coaches who were signed with the team. Please pray for me as I connect with a couple key players and coaches regarding their next steps in the athletic world, that I would be sensitive to where God might be leading me, and that I would get opportunities to pray for them.
