Dear North Peace Family,

Thank you for continuing to stand with us in prayer, words of encouragement and financial support.

~We especially covet your prayer as we continue to partner with, encourage and strengthen Aboriginal Christians and other believers to make disciples through the Good News.

~Please continue to pray concerning the CRTC approval of the Sunrise Radio power upgrade from 50 watts to 2000 watts. We need patience and wisdom as we face roadblocks and detours in this process. Transmitters are not readily available. After several dead-ends, a company has promised delivery in April, for 92.5fm Fort St. John. The antenna, used by Christian radio all over the world and recommended by the engineer for the Dawson Creek 107.5fm application, has proved to be unsuitable for our northern climate. Technicians are seeking the Lord to find an economic solution. Climbing towers in winter weather is challenging, please pray for safety.

~Please pray for revival of His work, among the Tahltan and other indigenous people, causing many to put their trust in the Word of God

~We praise God that Al's cataract surgery this fall has been successful and his cancer continues to be in remission.
